### Strengths

Lowell Elementary's strength comes from its community. From classroom teachers and school support staff to parents, families, and external organizations, Lowell is a community strongly connected to its school and the success of all students.

### Progress

The percentage of students in grades 3-5 scoring proficient in Reading on the Spring MAP, was 52% in 2017, two points lower than the rate for Spring 2016. In the area of Mathematics, proficiency was achieved by 56% of students in grades 3-5 on the MAP Spring assessment, a 10 point increase from the previous spring's benchmark score of 46%.

### Area for Growth

Across the 2017-2018 school year, instructional practices will continue to grow from past successes, pushing more heavily into the Focus Lesson in both Math and Literacy, flexible grouping, and cross curricular connections. We will also be working toward expansion of our PBS work to continue to grow thinking around what it means to be an inclusive school for students and our community.

### Vision Connection

Our school supports MMSD's vision that all students acquire the skills and abilities needed to be successful, including a mastery of content areas, growth mindset, self-knowledge, creativity, wellness, interpersonal skills, confidence, cultural competence, and community connection. 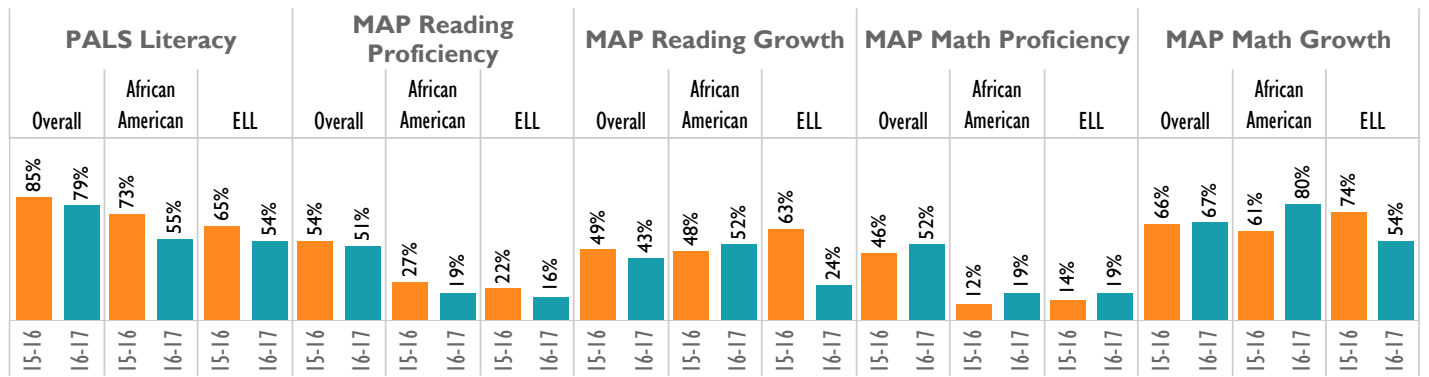

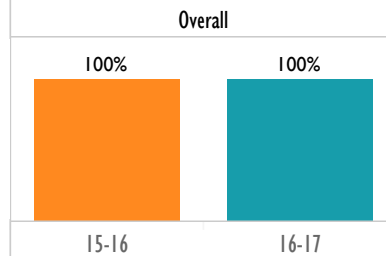
## Strategic Framework Goal #1 Milestones: On-Track to Graduate
