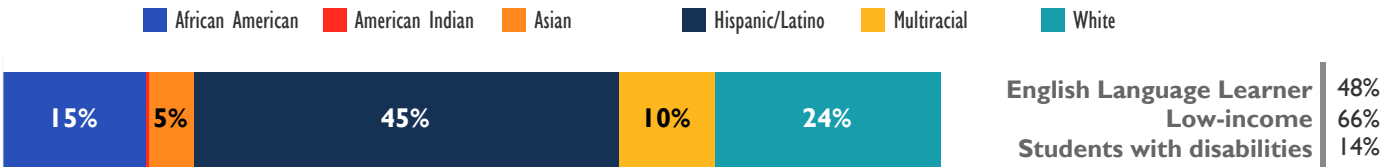
## Area for Growth

## Vision Connection

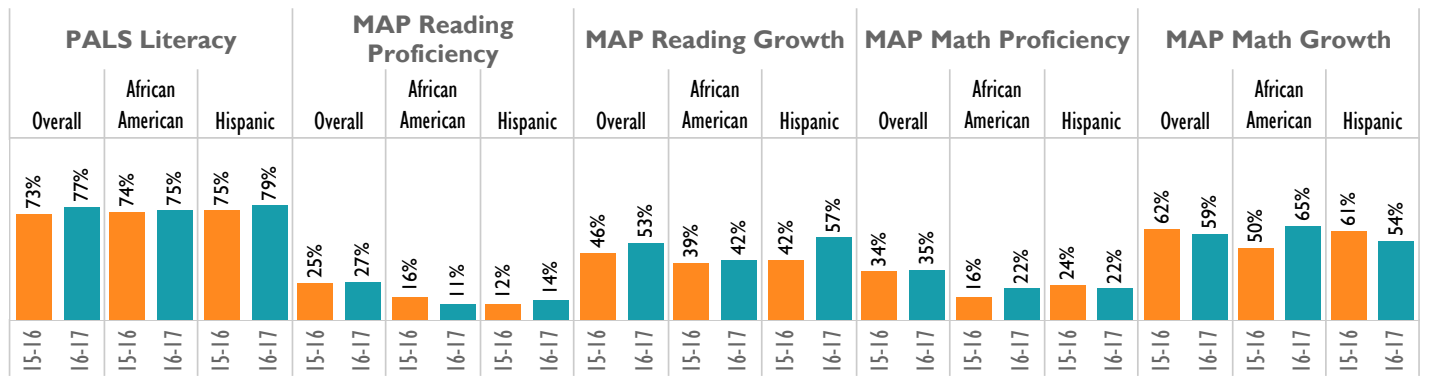

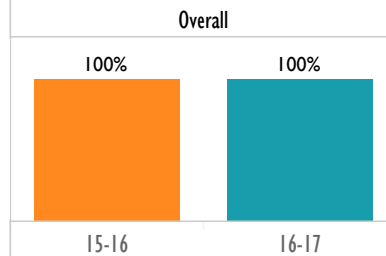
## Strategic Framework Goal #1 Milestones: On-Track to Graduate
